



CLEANUP BUCKET LIST

A bucket is full of home-recovery supplies that are needed after a disaster strikes.

SUPPLIES NEEDED (All cleaning items must be new and all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened):

- One 4-8oz. pump spray air freshener
- One five-gallon bucket with resealable lid (if reused, scrub clean. Do not use a bucket that has held chemicals of any kind)
- Four scouring pads
- Seven sponges, including one large
- One scrub brush
- 18 reusable, lightweight dry cleaning towels (e.g. Handi wipes)
- One 50oz. or two 25oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- One 16-28oz. bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap
- One 12-17oz. bottle of household cleaner that can be mixed with water (no spray bottles)
- One package of 48-50 clothespins
- Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
- Five dust masks
- Two pairs of heavy-duty, waterproof dishwashing gloves (latex-free, non-surgical)
- One pair of work gloves (cotton with leather palm or all leather)
- 24-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll and removed from carton
- One 6-9oz. bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent



Fitting all items into the bucket can be a challenge. To ensure everything is packed securely and to avoid damage during shipment, place the larger items into the bucket first, then add the smaller items. For more tips on how to pack your bucket, watch the how-to video at fosohio.org/bucket-list.
